16-18 Age Group Par 70 6051 Yards

Daniel Goode of Wytheville, VA won the age group with a score of 4 over par 74. Goode recorded 3 birdies and an eagle on the round that also included a double and triple bogey. The eagle came on hole 18 when he made the shot from 32 yards away. Goode said, "After the triple on #4, I just focused on hitting the shot rather than the outcome of the shot. Golf is a game where you get good breaks and bad breaks. I just had to focus on what I could control and that was the execution of each shot. I just played golf like it is meant to be played." It was certainly good strategy as he played the rest of the round in 3 under par to gain a six shot advantage over Noah Barr of Chilhowie, VA and Jason Hall of Dublin, VA. The pair tied for 2nd with scores of 80.

14-15 Age Group Par 70 5691 Yards

Jake Albert of Christiansburg, VA shot 82 and won the age group. Albert made 2 birdies and recorded 5 pars en route to his two shot victory over McKenzie Weddle of Floyd, VA. Benson Blevins of Wytheville, VA shot 85 and finished 3rd.

12-13 Age Group Par 70 4990 Yards

Talan Gentry of Hillsville, VA won the age group for the second consecutive week with a score of 92. Grayson Sheets of Marion, VA was 2nd one shot back at 93. Grayden Laird of Galax, VA was 3rd with a score of 96.

10-12 Age Group Par 34 2011 Yards

Grant McCall of Richlands, VA shot 40 to win the age group by one shot. Major Ewing of Blacksburg, VA and Jack Skinner also of Blacksburg, VA shot 41 to finish tied for 2nd. David Goode of Wytheville, VA was solo 4th with a score of 42. "All four players had a stellar round making for a very competitive age group. In the spirit of sportsmanship they genuinely root for each other. It is inspiring to see." (comment from Dewayne Belcher)

9 and Under Age Group Par 34 2520 Yards

Hudson Hurt of Radford, VA won the age group with a score of 38. Campbell Sayers of Marion, VA was second with a score of 45. Nolan Hurt of Radford, VA was third with a score of 58.
